OUR PAST EVENTS

Thank you to the many Brown alumni who sponsored and supported thirteen Brown Club events over the past year, in addition to the full support and active participation of our Board of Directors.

We began the 2015-16 season in September with an afternoon for fans of Greenwich Polo, coordinated by **Dr. Steven Fern '86** and **Jesse Poole '94**. Later in September, we heard **Ray Rhinehart '62** present an architectural tour of the Brown campus at Bush-Holley House in Cos Cob coordinated by **Dr. Steven Fern '86** and **Richard Williamson '65**.

In October, Lisa Ryan-Boyle '89 and Jane Sprung '88 arranged for Director of Admissions Jim Miller '73 to speak to an audience of prospective students and their parents at The King School in Stamford. And, in November, The Brown Sports Foundation sponsored a tent at the Brown-Yale football game in New Haven. Also in November, Daryl and Peggy Twitchell '93 and Gavriel Rosenfeld '89 organized a wonderful wine and hors d'oeuvres tasting at the Westport Country Playhouse in Westport.

In February, 2016 **Darcy Travlos '84** hosted a reprise of our successful alumni networking event at Barcelona in Greenwich. In April, Lloyd and **Jane Sprung '88** and **Darcy Travlos '84** arranged for **Sean Kelly '84** to speak about **S.J. Perelman '25**, noted Brown author and humorist, at the Sprung home in Greenwich. Also in April, Perry and **Lisa Ryan-Boyle '87** hosted an accepted students' party in Darien.

In May, along with the Brown Club of Westchester County and the Brown Sports Foundation, we arranged for a panel discussion with four head coaches from Brown at Rye Country Day School, hosted by Headmaster **Scott Nelson '77**.

We had a very busy June, with **Daryl and Peggy Twitchell '93** hosting a capacity crowd at the Silvermine Arts Center to hear Professor Wendy Schiller speak on 2016 Presidential Politics. The next weekend, **Gavriel Rosenfeld '89**, **Erika Banks '89**, and **David Muller '81** sponsored the ever-popular Lobster Bake, this time at The Saugatuck Rowing Club in Westport. The next week **Daryl and Peggy Twitchell '93** hosted Shakepeare-on-the Sound's "Hamlet" at Pinkney Park in Rowayton.

Finally, in August, **Jane Sprung '88** arranged for a send-off party at her home in Greenwich for Fairfield County students entering the Brown Class of 2020.

BROWN ALUMNI INTERVIEWING PROGRAM

We had an active interview season, though thankfully without the snowy weather encumbrances of past years. In coordination with Brown, we pared down our college fair participation to one event, at Central Magnet School in Bridgeport. We also hosted the ever-popular Introduction to Brown at the King School, which this year featured outgoing Dean of Admission James Miller '73, who shared his years of wisdom about the University and the admission process.

We saw a significant increase in candidates from our area last year, which matched the rise in global applicants to Brown. Like Brown, our BAIP area encountered the largest applicant pool ever: 326 students, all of whom received interviews thanks to the hard work of our alumni interview volunteers. Of those applying from Fairfield Countyschools, 24 from our area will be matriculating into the Class of 2020.

After admission decisions were made, our work shifted in tone to activities that are more celebratory in nature. We brought back the Brown in your Town reception for accepted students, hosted by Lisa Ryan-Boyle '87 on a beautiful spring day in April. The event was attended by more than 40 students, parents and alumni who helped persuade undecided students to choose Brown over other admission choices. On August 24th, Jane Sprung '88 hosted our annual Send Off Party at her home, where matriculating students to the Class of 2020 had the opportunity to gather and connect before heading to Providence.

After five dedicated and successful years, Lisa Ryan-Boyle '87 reached the end of her term and stepped down as co-Chair of BAIP. I am very excited to continue the work I began last year as co-Chair and look forward getting to know all of you who volunteer for the Alumni Interviewing Program.
