
#### **Brown Clubs**

<u>First Readings</u> is a shared intellectual endeavor for Brown's first-year and transfer students. Students collectively read an assigned book over the summer and submit response papers at the start of the school year. The chosen work for 2019 is Elif Batuman's The Idiot.

## First, choose the type of event you'd like to host:

- a) Community Reading Read the book as a community and host a book club-style gathering to discuss it.
- b) Guided Reading Use <u>discussion questions</u>, media, and book reviews to <u>lead a</u> <u>productive meeting</u>.
