How to get started:

1. Choose a local organization that is meaningful to local alumni.
2. Contact an organization to propose your service event.
3. Apply for Program Funding for food, drink and/or supplies, if needed. (See pages 24-25 of the [Club Leader Toolkit pdf](#).) Submit Program Funding application by Monday, January 22, 2018.
4. Promote the event on your club's website, Facebook page, [Brown event calendar](#), and/or send an email blast to local alumni. Order name tags three weeks before the event by emailing Alumni_Clubs@Brown.edu.
5. Take photos at the event and post them to your club's website and Facebook page and share them with baaphotos@gmail.com.
