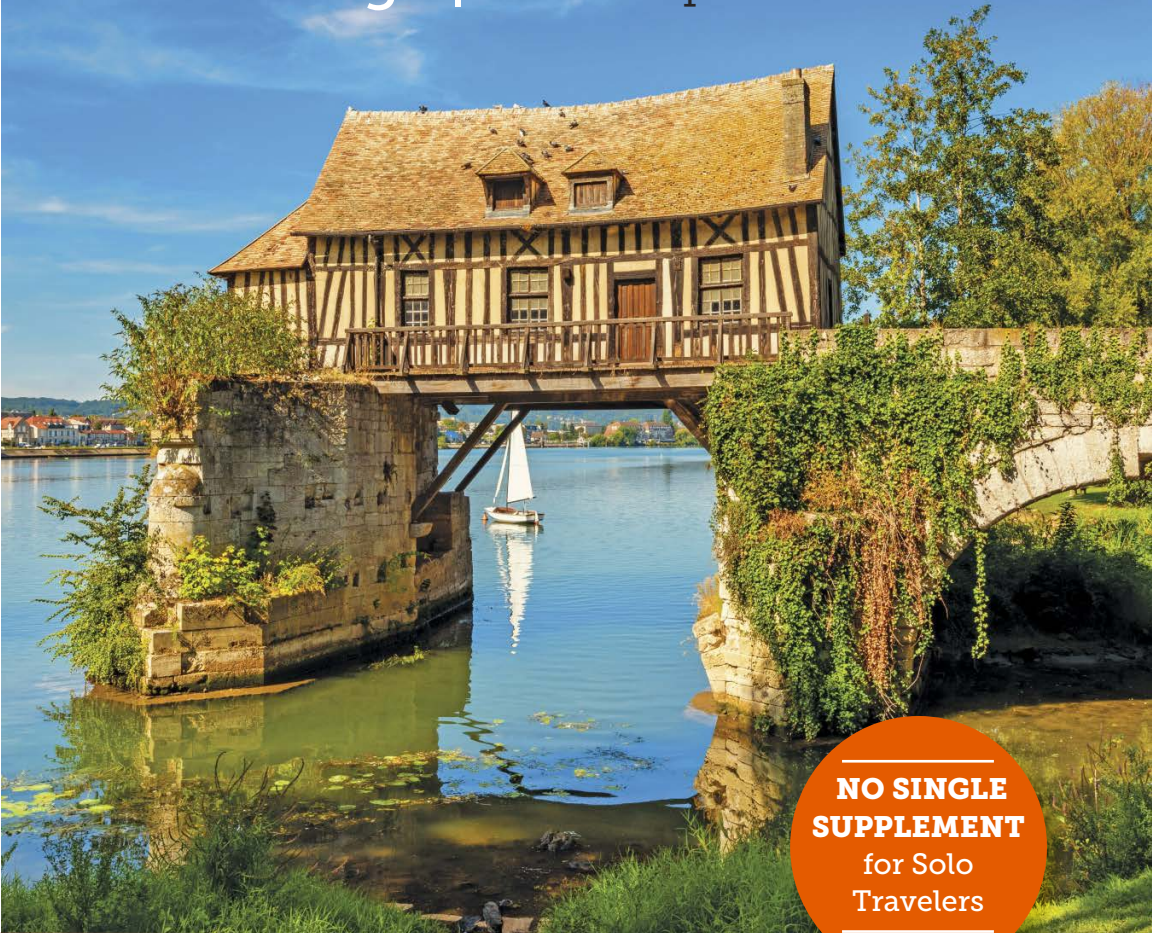

Day 1 | In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Paris, France. 🌐

Day 2 | Paris, France

Upon arrival in Paris, transfer 🔄 to the MS Amadeus Diamond. Settle in your cabin and get acquainted with the ship's amenities.

Gather for a Welcome Reception and Dinner. Then bid farewell to Paris as the ship departs for your Seine cruise. You will return to magical Paris soon!

Day 3 | Conflans-Sainte-Honorine | Versailles

Discovery: Conflans-Sainte-Honorine.

Enjoy an enriching guided walk in this colorful town, located at the confluence of the Seine and Oise Rivers.

Discovery: Versailles. Journey to Versailles, France's grandest palace. Versailles was France's political capital and seat of the royal court from 1682-1789. See the opulent rooms, sprawling gardens and famous Hall of Mirrors. The Treaty of Versailles, which ended World War I, was signed in the famous Hall of Mirrors.

Day 4 | Jumièges | Rouen

Discovery: Ancient Abbeys. Venture into the French countryside to visit the ruins of the Benedictine Abbey of Jumièges, one of the most powerful abbeys in medieval France. Known for its charity toward the poor, it was one of several monasteries built along the River Seine. The ruins of the current building are from the 11th century, but the original monastery was built 300 years earlier. See the abbey's cloisters and the remains of the Église St Pierre. Continue to Abbey Saint-Wandrille, recognized as one of Normandy's first Benedictine abbeys. The buildings, which flaunt

rococo-style and Gothic decorations, still house a monastic community.

Discovery: Rouen. Delight in a walking tour of historic Rouen. The medieval quarter is filled with ornate Gothic churches and half-timbered houses and was once described in a Victor Hugo poem as “the city with a hundred bell towers chiming in the air.” Witness Notre-Dame de Rouen, the city’s grand cathedral captured so brilliantly in paintings by Monet. Marvel at Le Gros-Horloge, the famous astronomical clock. Along the way, listen to tales of Joan of Arc. Enjoy a delicious dinner on the ship.

Day 5 | Le Havre | Étretat | Honfleur

Discovery: Étretat. The grand white cliffs and arches along Étretat’s coastline are represented in nearly 80 works of art by Claude Monet. Thrill to outstanding views and unique spectacles during a gentle walk along a cliff-top path.

PYJ | Choose one of these excursions:

•**Calvados Farm Tour.** Head to the country to visit a family-run cider farm. Tour the farm and learn about the production of pure fruit juices, yummy Calvados and Pommeau, a delightful mixture of apple juice and apple brandy. Enjoy a sampling of these special items! (*Active*)

•**Musée d’art moderne André Malraux.** Join a tour of the MUMA, an art museum known for its wonderful collections by Renoir, Pissarro, Sisley and Degas as well as Boudin and Raoul Dufy.

•**Deauville.** Delight in a walking tour of Deauville, a beautiful seaside resort along the Côte Fleurie that is known as the “Parisian Riviera.” Stroll along the boardwalk, lined with elegant shops, centuries-old hotels and golden-sand beaches.

Discovery: Honfleur. Continue the day as you uncover Honfleur, a French port town that has captivated artists for centuries, including Claude





Normandy American Cemetery, Colleville-sur-Mer

Monet, Gustave Courbet and native son Eugène Boudin. Soak up the maritime ambience of its picture-perfect, 17th-century Vieux Bassin, or old harbor, located where the Seine River meets the English Channel. Stroll through the pretty harbor and along the narrow side streets to see the city's landmarks. The wooden Church of Sainte-Catherine, crafted by 15th-century shipbuilders, is a special stand-out, with ceilings over its two naves that resemble upturned hulls.

Enrichment: Normandy Culture, History & People. Join a local expert to learn about the rich, fascinating history of the Normandy area. Cap off the day with a lively singing performance.

Day 6 | Caen | Arromanches | D-Day Beaches | Caudebec-en-Caux

Discovery: Normandy and D-Day. Begin a memorable journey into World War II history at the Caen Peace Memorial Museum, a premier World War II museum. This celebrated site features engrossing exhibits, photos and videos that explore the impact of the war. Following lunch at the museum, continue to Arromanches and visit the Landings Museum.

Then set foot on Omaha Beach. As you walk along the beach, contemplate the extraordinary bravery of the Allied landing forces, who advanced under devastating fire across the heavily fortified shoreline to overcome German troops. Throughout your excursion, your guide shares details about this treacherous mission. Continue to Colleville-sur-Mer to pay a poignant visit to the Normandy American Cemetery. The cemetery overlooking Omaha Beach contains 9,385 graves of Americans who died in the invasion and subsequent battles as well as a memorial garden honoring those soldiers missing in action.

Day 7 | Les Andelys | Giverny | Vernon

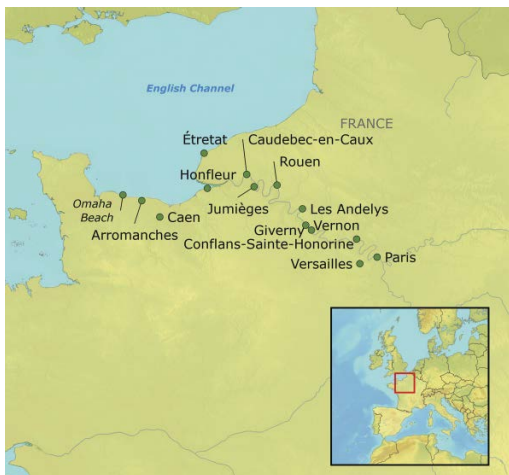
Discovery: Monet, His Life in Giverny.

Delve into the life and work of impressionist Claude Monet at his home in Giverny. Raised in Normandy, Monet lived in this pink-washed house from 1883 to 1926. Admire the tranquil Japanese garden and pond filled with lilies, settings that inspired many of his paintings. See the green footbridge captured in his artistry, and visit the studio where Monet created his famous "Water Lilies" series. Inside the house, view rooms as they were in Monet's time, including the blue kitchen and cheerful yellow dining room.

Rejoin your ship in Vernon and relax over lunch while sailing to Paris.

Day 8 | Paris

Discovery: The Gems of Paris. See the City of Light during a cruise on the Seine. Admire Paris' iconic landmarks, such as the Louvre, and float under the graceful arches of charming bridges, including Pont-Neuf. Then join a walking tour of Paris' storied Latin Quarter on the Île de la Cité, the historic heart of the city. See the restoration process of Notre-Dame, the city's most famous cathedral, and cross the Pont de l'Achevêché, the Archbishop's Bridge, for a fascinating look at the Latin Quarter, one of the most famous neighborhoods on the Left Bank. Learn about the quarter's history, the architecture and the famous residents.



Free Time: The afternoon is free for shopping, exploring and tasting French cuisine!

Tonight, gather with your fellow travelers for a festive Farewell Reception and Dinner and raise a toast to your adventure!

Day 9 | In Transit

Following breakfast, transfer to the Paris airport for the return flight to your gateway city.

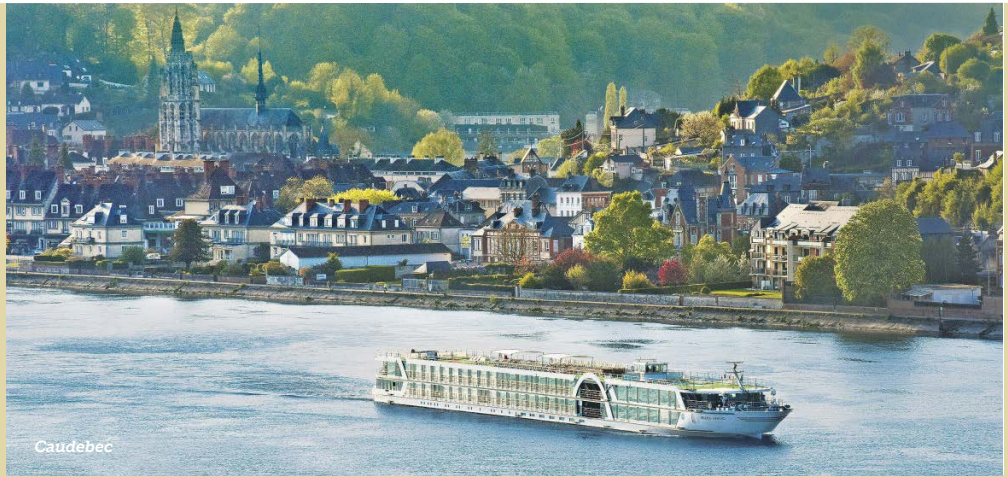

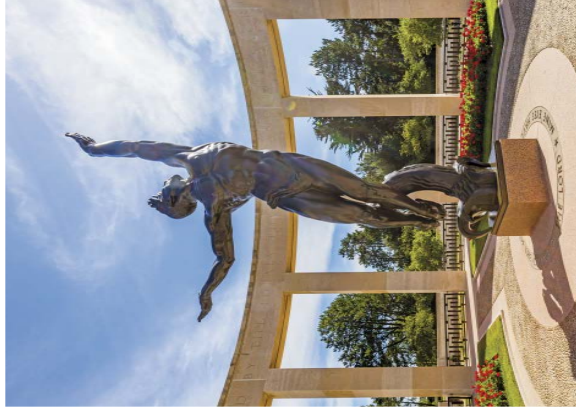
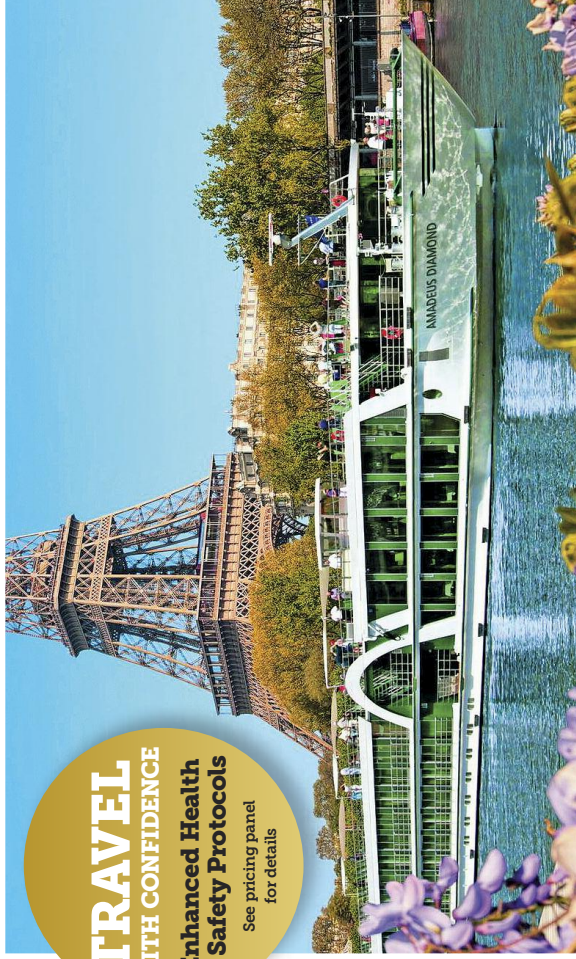
